### **NOTICE OF RACE**

**Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California**

#### **1. RULES:**

This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). The rules of J/105 Fleet One will be in effect. All competitors shall wear life jackets or other adequate personal buoyancy while racing.

#### **2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

2.1 The regatta is open to all members of a J/105 Fleet.

2.2 Eligible boats may be entered by completing the attached Entry Form and returning it with the entry fee to The San Francisco Yacht Club Race Office.

2.3 The entry fee is \$80 for members of US SAILING and \$85 for non-members, if received by June 4, 2004. The entry fee will be \$95 and \$100 respectively if received after June 4.

#### **4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Sailing instructions will be available after June 7, 2004, at The San Francisco Yacht Club, and on our web page, [www.sfyc.org](http://www.sfyc.org).

#### **5. WEIGH-IN**

Weigh-in is scheduled for Friday evening, Saturday morning, and Sunday morning. Weigh-in times are outlined in paragraph 11, Schedule of Events.

## 6. RACING AREA AND COURSES

The racing area will be in the vicinity of the Olympic Circle. The courses will be described in the sailing instructions.

## 7. COMMUNICATIONS

The Race Committee may use VHF channel 65 to communicate information about course selection, time to start, the class position relative to the starting time, and the sail numbers of boats that are OCS. Neither failure of the Race Committee to communicate the sail numbers of recalled boats in a timely manner, nor failure of a recalled boat to receive or hear transmitted information, will be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.

## 8. SCORING

The Low Point Scoring System, RRS A4, will apply. Four (4) races are scheduled, of which two (2) must be completed to constitute a series. All races will count toward the final score.

## 9. DOCKAGE

The SFYC guest dock will be available from June 11 through June 14.

## 10. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the top five boats in the regatta.

The trophy presentation will be held on the SFYC deck after the racing on Sunday.
