2005 SUMMER KEELBOAT – ACT 2 INVITATIONAL REGATTA J/120, Express 37, J/105 AUGUST 20-21, 2005

NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California

1. RULES:

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 The following rules are changed by this Notice: 62 and A2.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to the following classes:
J/120, Express 37, J/105
- 2.2 Eligible boats may be entered by completing the official Entry Form and returning it with the entry fee to The San Francisco Yacht Club Race Office.
- 2.3 The entry fee is \$70.00 for US SAILING members and \$75.00 for others. The fee will be \$90.00 for entries received after August 16.

3. PERSONAL BUOYANCY

All competitors are required to wear life jackets or adequate personal buoyancy while racing.

4. SCHEDULE OF RACES:

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

Sailing instructions will be available after August 17, 2005, at The San Francisco Yacht Club, and on our web page, www.sfyc.org.

6. RACING AREA AND COURSES:

The racing areas will be in the vicinity of the Olympic Circle. The courses will be described in the sailing instructions.

7. COMMUNICATIONS

The Race Committee may use VHF 65 to communicate information about course selection, time to start, the class position relative to the starting time, and the sail numbers of boats that are OCS. Neither failure of the Race Committee to communicate the sail numbers of recalled boats in a timely manner, nor failure of a recalled boat to receive or hear transmitted information, will be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.

8. SCORING:

The Low Point Scoring System, RRS A4, will apply. Five races are scheduled, of which two races must be completed to constitute a series. All races will count toward the final score. This changes RRS A2.

9. PRIZES:

Prizes will be awarded to the top three finishers in each class. The trophy presentation will be held on the SFYC deck after the racing on August 21.

10. BERTHING

Our guest docks will be available for racers from August 19-21.

11. PARKING

Parking in the SFYC lot will be restricted during the regatta. We will issue two parking passes per boat. We would appreciate all efforts to carpool or park off-site whenever possible. Passes may be picked up at the SFYC front desk on August 19 or 20. Maps showing off-site parking locations will be available on the SFYC web site, www.sfyc.org.
