NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California

1. RULES:

1.1 This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). The rules of J/105 Fleet One will be in effect.

1.2 All competitors are required to wear life jackets or other adequate personal buoyancy while racing.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

2.1 The regatta is open to all members of a J/105 Fleet.

2.2 Eligible boats may be entered by completing the attached Entry Form and returning it with the entry fee to The San Francisco Yacht Club Race Office.

2.3 The entry fee is \$90 for members of US SAILING and \$95 for non-members, if received by May 30, 2006. The entry fee will be \$100 if received after May 30.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

Sailing instructions will be available after May 30, 2006 at The San Francisco Yacht Club and on our website, www.sfyc.org.

4. WEIGH-IN:

Weigh-in dates and times are outlined in paragraph 11, Schedule of Events.

5. **RACING AREA AND COURSES:** The racing area will be in the vicinity of Treasure Island or the Olympic Circle. The courses will be described in the sailing instructions.
6. **COMMUNICATIONS:** The Race Committee may use VHF channel 65 to communicate information about the races.
7. **SCORING:** Five (5) races are scheduled, of which two (2) must be completed to constitute a series. All races will count toward the final score.
8. **DOCKAGE:** The SFYC guest dock will be available from June 2 through June 5.
9. **PRIZES:** Prizes will be awarded to the top five boats in the regatta. The trophy presentation will be held on the SFYC deck after the racing on Sunday.
