**NOTICE OF RACE**

**1.0 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), by the Sailing Instructions, by the J/105 Fleet One class rules & J/120 Fleet Five class rules, and by the International Sailing Federation Special Regulations (ISAF) January 2006-December 2007 for Category 2 Monohulls (except as modified by Attachment A). The full listing of ISAF Special Regulations for Category 2 Monohulls can be found at: [www.sailing.org](http://www.sailing.org)
- 1.2 RRS 40.1 is changed as follows: All competitors are required to wear a life jacket or other adequate personal floatation device while racing.

**2.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 2.1 The following classes are invited to participate: J/105, J120 & Express 27.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online registration form ([www.stfyc.com](http://www.stfyc.com)). Entries must be received by April 19<sup>th</sup> in order to avoid a late fee.

**3.0 FEES**

- 3.1 Entry fee is \$50, less \$5 with proof of current USSA membership, if received **by April 19<sup>th</sup>**.
- 3.2 Entry fee is \$60, less \$5 with proof of current USSA membership, if received **after April 19<sup>th</sup>**.

**4.0 SCHEDULE**

- 4.1 Late Registration: Saturday, April 22<sup>nd</sup> from 0930 hours to 1000 hours.
- 4.2 Racing will be held on Saturday, April 22<sup>nd</sup>. The scheduled time of the Warning Signal is 1100 hours.

**5.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The SI's will be available on the web site by April 19<sup>th</sup>, copies will also be available at the StFYC Front Desk by Friday, April 21<sup>st</sup>.

**6.0 RACING AREA**

The start area will be off Treasure Island. It is the intention of the Race Committee to run Course "A": Lightship to Port, finish downwind between StFYC A & B buoys. If conditions warrant an alternate course will be posted on the Official Notice Board & on the website by 0930 on April 22<sup>nd</sup>.

**7.0 SCORING**

One race will constitute a Series.

**8.0 SAFETY INSPECTION**

The Race Committee may perform random safety inspections after racing to ensure compliance with the ISAF Special Regulations for Category 2 Monohulls, except as modified by Attachment A. Boats failing inspection will be protested by the Race Committee as per RRS 60.2.

**9.0 BERTHING**

All yachts competing in the event may be moored free of charge at the StFYC guest docks one night prior to the beginning of racing and one night after racing concludes.

**10.0 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, decision to race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
