2006 SUMMER KEELBOAT – ACT 2 INVITATIONAL REGATTA 1D35, J/120, Express 37, and J/105 AUGUST 19-20, 2006

NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California

1. RULES:

1.1 This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

1.2 RRS 62.1 will be changed as described in section 7.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 The regatta is open to the following classes:

1D35, J/120, Express 37, and J/105

2.2 Eligible boats may be entered by completing online registration at www.sfyc.org.

2.3 The entry fee is \$ 95.00 for US SAILING members and \$100.00 for others. The fee will be \$110.00 for entries received after August 15.

2.3a To obtain the US SAILING discount, enter US SAILING as your National Governing Body, and your current US SAILING number, at the bottom right of the General Information Page of the registration form.

2.3b Credit cards will be accepted using the secure site that has been set up for this race by the 1BigThink Regatta Manager program. The option to charge yacht club accounts is available to SFYC members only.

3. PERSONAL BUOYANCY

All competitors are required to wear life jackets or adequate personal buoyancy while racing.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

Sailing instructions will be available after August 16, 2006, at The San Francisco Yacht Club, and on the Regatta-Manager website, accessible from www.sfyc.org.

6. RACING AREA AND COURSES:

The racing area will be in the vicinity of the Berkeley Olympic Circle. The courses will be described in the sailing instructions.

7. COMMUNICATIONS

The Race Committee may use VHF 65 to communicate information about course selection, time to start, the class position relative to the starting time, and the sail numbers of boats that are OCS. Neither failure of the Race Committee to communicate the sail numbers of recalled boats in a timely manner, nor failure of a recalled boat to receive or hear transmitted information, will be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1.

8. SCORING:

Five races are scheduled, of which two races must be completed to constitute a series. All races will count toward the final score.

9. PRIZES:

Prizes will be awarded to the top three finishers in each class.

The trophy presentation will be held on the SFYC deck after the racing on August 20.

10. BERTHING

Our guest docks will be available for racers from August 18-20.

11. PARKING

Parking in the SFYC lot will be restricted during the regatta. We will issue two parking passes per boat. We would appreciate all efforts to carpool or park off-site whenever possible. Passes may be picked up at the SFYC front desk on August 18 or 19. Maps showing off-site parking locations will be available at www.sfyc.org.
