

FLEET 1 J/105 WEIGHING
March 3, 2007

Administrative and boat preparation details of the March 3rd J/105 boat weighing are:

Administrative Details

1. The location of the weighing will be the Berkeley Marine Center (510) 843-8195, located 100 yards north of the Berkeley Yacht Club. The BMC has sufficient dock room to temporarily store boat items you are required to remove from your boat, but it is suggested that you leave sails at your home port. Also, you might want to bring large containers to accommodate miscellaneous equipment in drawers and lockers.
2. The hoisting schedule will start at 0900 hours at 15 minute intervals as follows:
0900 - Cuchulainn; 0915 - Wonder; 0930 - August West; 0945 - Liberty.
1000 - Spartan; 1015 - Walloping Swede; 1030 - Miss Demeanor; 1045 - Energy
1100 - Nantucket Sleighride; 1115 - Peregrine; 1130 - Ultimatum; 1145 - Bald Eagles
1200 - Anna Laura; 1215 - Vim; 1230 - Tenacity
3. Ensure your boat is ready for inspection 15-30 minutes prior to your weigh in time. If you are not ready to be weighed, you will be moved to the end of the line or the next open slot. No other repairs, sanding, etc. will be allowed during the weighing. An expeditious timetable is critical.
4. The cost of weighing each boat is \$150, which includes the yard and measurer's fees. Please bring a check made out to J/105 Fleet #1 for this amount.

Boat Preparation Details

1. Go to the J/105 Class home page: www.j105.org. Follow the directions under CLASS NEWS, Class Rules 01.Feb.07 – New Rules in Effect. Print a copy of the new rules, which includes EXHIBIT 7.3 C (Procedure for Weighing Boats) and 7.3 D (J/105 Weight Certificate). Prepare your boat using these EXHIBITs.
2. Make sure your boat bottom is clean. Boats with dirty bottoms will not be weighed.
3. Backstays are to be disconnected above the pump and tied to the mast in order for the boat to be backed into the proper travel lift position.
4. Bilges, water tanks and head tanks must be dry.
