NOTICE OF RACE

1.0 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions, and by the J/105 Fleet One class rules.
- 1.2 Racing rule 40.1 will be changed as follows: All competitors are required to wear a life jacket or other adequate personal floatation device while racing.

2.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 J/105 Fleet One members are invited to participate.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form located at www.stfyc.com. Entries must be submitted by May 9, in order to avoid late fee.

3.0 FEES

- 3.1 Entry fee is \$95, less \$5 with proof of current USSA membership, if **received by May 9**.
- 3.2 Entry fee is \$105, less \$5 with proof of current USSA membership, if received **after May 9**.

4.0 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Late Registration: Saturday, May 12 from 930 hours to 1000 hours.
- 4.2 Racing will be held on Saturday, May 12 & Sunday, May 13, with three races on Saturday and two on Sunday.
- 4.3 The Warning Signal for the first race each day is scheduled for 1100 hours. There will not be a Sailors' Meeting.
- 4.4 All competitors and their guests are invited to attend a regatta social after racing on Saturday, as well as a trophy ceremony on Sunday afternoon.

5.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at St. Francis on Saturday, May 12, while an **unofficial** copy may be found on the StFYC web site by Wednesday, May 9.

6.0 RACING AREA

Racing will take place on the City Front around inflatable marks.

7.0 SCORING

- 7.1 One race shall constitute a series.
- 7.2 Five races are scheduled in the series, all of which shall count towards a boats final score.

7.0 BERTHING

All yachts competing in the event may be moored free of charge at the StFYC guest docks one night prior to the beginning of racing and one night after racing concludes.

8.0 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, decision to race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
