

FLEET 1 J/105 WEIGHING
August 11, 2008

Administrative and boat preparation details of the August 11, 2008 J/105 boat weighing are:

Administrative Details

1. The location of the weighing will be Anderson's Boat Yard, 400 Harbor Drive, Sausalito, CA 94965 (415) 332-5432. Anderson's has sufficient dock space to temporarily store boat items you are required to remove from your boat, but it is suggested that you leave sails at your homeport, if possible. Also, you might want to bring large containers to accommodate miscellaneous equipment from drawers and lockers rather than have loose items sitting on the dock.
2. The hoisting schedule will start at 1330 hours at 15 minute intervals as follows: 1330- Larrikin; 1345- Roxanne; 1400- Wife not Happy; 1445-Joe's boat; Ensure your boat is ready for inspection 30 minutes prior to your weigh in time. If you are not ready to be weighed, you will be moved to the end of the line or the next open slot. No other repairs, sanding, etc. will be allowed during the weighing. An expeditious timetable is critical.
3. The cost of weighing each boat is \$150, which includes the yard's and measurer's fees. Please bring a check made out to J/105 Fleet #1 for this amount.

Boat Preparation Details

1. Go to the National J/105 Class home page: www.j105.org. Click on Racing and then Rules. Print a copy of EXHIBIT 7.3A (Procedure for Weighing Boats) and 7.3B (J/105 Weight Certificate). Prepare your boat using these EXHIBITS.
2. Make sure your boat bottom is clean. Boats with dirty bottoms will not be weighed.
3. Backstays are to be disconnected above the pump and tied to the mast so your boat may be backed into the proper travel lift position.
4. Bilges, water tanks and holding tanks must be empty.
