

FLEET 1 J/105 WEIGHING
July 28, 2007

Administrative and boat preparation details of the July 28 J/105 boat weighing are:

Administrative Details

1. The location of the weighing will be Anderson's Boat Yard, (800) 310-5432, located in Sausalito. Anderson's has sufficient dock room to temporarily store boat items you are required to remove from your boat, but it is suggested that you leave sails at your home port. Also, you might want to bring large containers to accommodate miscellaneous equipment in drawers and lockers.
2. The hoisting schedule will start at 0930 hours at 15 minute intervals as follows:
0930 - Chilaxn; 0945 - Bandwidth; 1000 - Mojo; 1015 - Ultimatum;
1030 - Seas the Day; 1045-Nirvana
Ensure your boat is ready for inspection 15-30 minutes prior to your weigh in time. If you are not ready to be weighed, you will be moved to the end of the line or the next open slot. No other repairs, sanding, etc. will be allowed during the weighing. An expeditious timetable is critical.
3. The cost of weighing each boat is \$150, which includes the yard's and measurer's fees. Please bring a check made out to J/105 Fleet #1 for this amount.

Boat Preparation Details

1. Go to the National J/105 Class home page: www.j105.org. Click on Racing and then Rules. Print a copy of EXHIBIT 7.3 C (Procedure for Weighing Boats) and 7.3 D (J/105 Weight Certificate). Prepare your boat using these EXHIBITs.
2. Make sure your boat bottom is clean. Boats with dirty bottoms will not be weighed.
3. Back stays are to be disconnected above the pump and tied to the mast so your boat may be backed into the proper travel lift position.
4. Bilges, water tanks and head tanks must be dry.
