FLEET 1 PROCESS FOR WEIGHING BOATS
March 25, 2006

The second general weighing date for Fleet 1 J/105s has been scheduled for Saturday, March 25, 2006. Results of the 2/25/06 weighing in Berkeley are located on our Fleet web site www.sfj105.org under Fleet Notices.

Details of the March 25 weighing include:

1. Weighing will start at 1000 and occur every twenty minutes until all boats are weighed.
2. The location of the weighing will be Anderson's Boat Yard, 400 Harbor Drive, Sausalito (415) 332-5432. The Yard has sufficient dock room to temporarily store boat items you are required to remove from your boat, but you might want to leave sails at your home port. Also, you might want to bring large containers to accommodate miscellaneous equipment in drawers and lockers.
3. Go to the J/105 Class home page: www.j105.org. Click on Class News 02Feb06-New Rules, direct link. Print a copy of the new rules which includes the weight rule 7.3 C & D. Ensure your boat is ready for inspection 15-30 minutes prior to your weigh in time. If you are not ready to be weighed in, you will be moved to the end of the line or the next open slot. No other repairs, sanding, etc. will be allowed during the weighing. An expeditious timetable is critical.
4. Make sure your boat bottom is clean. Boats with dirty bottoms will not be weighed. Back stays are to be disconnected.
5. The cost of weighing each boat on February 25 is \$150 which includes the yard's and measurer's fee. Please bring a check made out to J/105 Fleet #1 for this amount.
6. Lastly, email benedictpw@aol.com to reserve a weigh in time. We will do our best to honor your request on a first come first served basis. Choose a time on the hour or twenty minute interval or a range of times between 1000 and 1200 and we will do our best to accommodate you.

Boats presently signed up (but still need to act on #6 above), are: Arbitrage, Good Timin', Orion, Blackhawk, Lulu, Breeze and Streaker.
